

48 YACHTS COMPETE AT NEW ROCHELLE

Largest Fleet to Race This Season Out at Annual Regatta.

NEW ROCHELLE, N. Y., July 5.—Commodore C. A. Marsland and the members of the New Rochelle Yacht Club were well repaid today. During the war the organization, in the face of considerable opposition on the part of some of its members and yachtsmen in other clubs, insisted upon carrying out its full racing program. It took the stand at the request of the Navy Department and was followed by several of the other Long Island Sound organizations.

The club held its thirty-fourth annual regatta today and had no less than forty-eight yachts at the starting line. It was the largest fleet that has raced so far this season on Long Island Sound.

When Chairman George P. Granbery established the starting line off the entrance to Echo Bay, the wind was light, and so fluky that the committee decided that it would be absurd to attempt to start the yachts. After waiting for a half-hour, the New York Yacht Club thirty-footers, the largest class to fill, were sent away on a 15½-mile contest. It was twice around a 7¾-mile triangle, and as the wind came at the start the yachts had a run, a reach, and a beat.

As the afternoon advanced the northwest breeze died away, and the good, old southwest air that springs up regularly each afternoon came lightly across the Sound. It completely changed the race. On the second time around the triangle the yachts had a run, a beat, and a reach. At the finish Rowdy, the property of C. Belsky, was the leader, defeating Ogden Reid's Lena by 4 minutes and 2 seconds.

Two of the Long Island Sound schooners were sent over a shorter course. The winner was E. P. Alker's Allure. Sirene won in the Larchmont Inter-Club class. As usual, the Star class had the most starters, no less than thirteen of the popular little fellows coming to the starting line. Saturn, the property of George W. Elder, Jr., which has been doing most consistent work this Summer, again was the victor, defeating Altair, the property of E. V. Willis, by 1 minute and 52 seconds over a 7¾-mile course.
